Are you having surgery to remove your gallbladder?

This hospital is taking part in a study called P-iGBC. The study aims to develop a diagnostic model for incidental gallbladder cancer.

Gallbladder cancer is <u>very</u> rare but is sometimes diagnosed after routine surgery. Inclusion in P-iGBC does not mean that you have been identified as high-risk for incidental cancer.

This observational study won't change your care. If included, your clinical team will collect data from your medical record. **This may be done without your consent unless you opt-out**. Anonymised data will be shared with the team co-ordinating the research at University Hospitals Plymouth and the University of Plymouth.

The first phase is led by a senior surgical registrar as part of a doctoral degree.

No-one, apart from your local clinical team, will be able to work out who you are from the data shared with the researchers.
